OCP & Zoning Bylaw Review and Update

The RM of Meota No. 468 Council is reviewing and updating their Official Community Plan (OCP) and Zoning Bylaw. The current bylaws were approved in 2011, and therefore need updating to reflect current trends and regulations. Official Community Plans provide vision and policy to guide Council in decision-making for the future development and growth of the community. The Zoning Bylaw outlines regulations that all development must follow to ensure the health, safety, and orderly development of the community. A community's Zoning Bylaw must align with their Official Community Plan.

- May 3rd – Council Presents Draft #2 to Hamlet Boards
- June 5th – Council considers Draft #3 for Information at Regular Council Meeting
- June 14th – Public Engagement Session on Draft #3
- July 3rd – Council considers Draft # 4 for information at Regular Council Meeting
- July 26th – Council presents Draft #4 at Annual Rate Payer Meeting
- August 7th – Council considers first reading of amended OCP & Zoning Bylaw
- September 4th – Council considers second and third reading of amended OCP & Zoning Bylaw
- Upon Approval, Council forwards the bylaws to Community Planning for final adoption (typically a 90-day approval timeline).
